

Chart for Aran/Taos – allover fern pattern, sleeveless shell

Charts all represent sts as seen from front (RS) of knitting.
 Odd numbered rows are knit from right to left as shown by symbols
 Even rows are knit from left to right of chart and sts are reversed.
 Thus on even row a blank st box = K on RS, but P on WS.

This first stitch column is only at outside selvedge edge

Repeat pattern is 12 rows x 12 stitches
 Odd rows = RS, read right to left
 Even rows = WS, read left to right

symbol	meaning of symbol
	Blank = Knit on RS, Purl on WS
-	Purl on RS, K on WS
○	YO – yarn over
↘	Dec – lean to right = k2tog
↙	Dec – lean to left = SSK or Sl1-k1-ssso
↘↙	Dbl right slanting decrease (- 2 sts)

To work double right slanting decrease: Insert the right needle knitwise into 3 stitches on left needle, knit together.
