

Crystal Palace Yarns (sw 098a)

Cameo Father - Son Cable Vest (adult)

Designed and Knit by Dawn Leeseman for Crystal Palace Yarns

Finished Measurements (after seaming) 38.5 (40.75) (44) (48) (50) (53.50)

Materials Crystal Palace [Cameo](#): 9 (10) (11) (12) (13) (14) - 50 gr balls #0214 "cobblestone"; Crystal Palace Bamboo or Daisy Needles: Sizes US 10 (6mm) and 10-1/2 (6.5mm) 26" circular; Size 10 (6 mm) 16" circular *OR size to obtain gauge*; Cable needle; 3 stitch holders

Gauge 15 sts & 20 rows = 4" blocked with larger ndls in St st.

16 sts = 2 3/4" using 10-1/2 ndl in 16 st Cable Panel

Be sure to make a gauge swatch before beginning project. A swatch is also a good time to practice making the cable panel before beginning the vest.

Abbreviations Beg-beginning; BO-bind off; CO-cast on; Dec-decrease; K- knit; K2tog- knit 2 stitches together; patt-pattern; pm-place marker; Rem- remaining; Rep-repeat; Rnds-rounds; RS-right side; SSK- slip slip knit; St(s)-stitch (es); WS-wrong side.

Instructions

Back Using size 10 ndls, CO 80 (84) (90) (98) (102) (108) sts. Work in rib patt as

follow: (RS) **Row 1:** K2 * p1, k1 rep from * to end of row (WS) **Row 2:** *P1, k1 rep from * to last 2 sts, end p2. *Note: The K2 at beg of Row 1 and p2 at the end of Row 2, creates an edge for seaming front rib to back rib, it keeps the continuity of the rib and has a nice finish.* Rep these 2 rows for a total of 11 rows. End after working a

Row 1. Change to size 10-1/2 ndls; begin patt as foll: (WS) **Rows 1,3,5, 7, and 9:**

P 32 (34) (37) (41) (43) (46) sts, k2, p12, k2, (center cable panel); p 32 (34) (37)

(41) (43) (46) sts. **Row 2:** K 32 (34) (37) (41) (43) (46) sts; p2, sl next 3 sts to cable ndl and hold

in back, k3 from LN, then k3 from cable ndl; sl next 3 sts to cable ndl and hold in front, k3 from left

ndl, then k3 from cable ndl; p2; k 32 (34) (37) (41) (43) (46) sts. **Rows 4, 6, 8 and 10:** K 32 (34)

(37) (41) (43) (46) sts; p2, k12, p2; k 32 (34) (37) (41) (43) (46) sts. Rep these 10 rows until piece

meas 15 (15.5) (16) (16.5) (17) (17.5)", or desired length to underarm from CO edge, end after

working WS row. *Note: When measuring length, measure up the middle of the Stockinette section on*

either side of the cable panel. **Armhole Shaping** Cont to work in patt, BO 3 (4) (4) (5) (5) (5) sts at

beg next 2 rows. **Dec Row:** K1, ssk, patt across to last 3 st, k2tog, k1. Rep dec row every RS row 2

(2) (3) (4) (5) (6) more times. [68 (70) (74) (78) (80) (84) sts.] Work even in patt as estab until

armhole meas 8.5 (9) (10) (11) (11.5) (12)", begin shoulder shaping. End after working WS row.

Neck and shoulder shaping: Working both sides at same time, BO 9 (9) (10) (11) (11) (11) sts, k

to center 30 (32) (34) (34) (36) (38) sts, place on st holder, join 2nd ball of yarn and k to end of row.

Next Row: BO 9 (9) (10) (11) (11) (11) sts in p, p rem sts; next shoulder; p rem sts. **Next 2 Rows:**

BO 10 (10) (10) (11) (11) (12) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Front Work same as for the back to Armhole Shaping. AT THE SAME TIME divide and begin **Neck**

Shaping Cont armhole shaping, work across in patt as estab to cable panel, pm, .work 8 sts of cable

panel, join 2nd ball of yarn and work across 8 cable panel sts, pm, work across rem sts. Work 1 row

even. **Dec Row:** (1st side) Work to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, p2, k6; 2nd side, k6, p2, ssk, work

across. Cont to work in patt as estab. **Rep Dec row every RS row:** 10 (11) (12) (11) (11) (11)

times more and **every row 4, 4 (4) (5) (6) (7) times.** Work even until armhole meas same as for

back. Work shoulder shaping same as for back.

Finishing Sew shoulder and side seams. Work Neck and armhole trim. Work in all ends.

Neck Trim Using size 10, 26" circular ndls, beg at left shoulder, pu 36 (38) (40) (42) (44) (46) along

left front neck edge, pm, pu 1 st in the center of neck division, pm, pu 36 (38) (40) (42) (44) (46)

along right neck edge; pu 4 sts along right shoulder; dec 6 sts evenly as you work the 30 (32) (34)

(34) (36) (38) sts from back stitch holder; 4 sts along left shoulder. 105 (111) (117) (121) (127)

(133) sts. Join and work in rnds as foll: **Rnd 1:** Work in K1, P1 rib as estab to 2 sts before center

marker, ssk, sl marker, k1 (center st), sl marker, k2tog, p1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd. Work

5 rnds of rib as estab, k the knit sts and p the purl sts, working dec on each side of center marker.

BO all sts in rib patt. **Armhole Trim** Using size 10, 16" circular ndls, beg at underarm seam, pu 70

(74) (82) (90) (92) (96) sts. Join and work in K1, p1 rib for 5 rnds. BO all sts in rib.
